

ART CLAYTM SILVER **Basic Instruction Guide**

Snow Boot Pendant



Completed piece

Christmas is here! So we have use the snow boots as a pendant motif. We wish it collects lots of presents and happiness.

<Material>

A-053	Art Clay Silver 650/1200 Clay Type 10g (use 8g)	1pc
C-017	Bead chain 40cm (φ1.50) (SV925)	1pc

<Step by Step Guide>



1) Roll about 7g of clay into a 2.5cm rope.



2) Press both ends on the work surface to flatten.



3) Moisten the entire piece so as not to crack, and bend L-shape 1cm away from one end.



4) Press both ends on the work surface again to flatten and dry well.



5) Smooth the entire piece with a medium fine file.



6) Draw a line with a pencil 3mm away from the boot top end, and cut in the line lightly with a craft knife.



7) Cut in a wavy line with the craft knife.



8) Extend the line with a fine narrow-grip file No.1/ Barrette, then smooth the entire piece with a red sponge sanding pad (#320-600) and fire.



9) Make two small balls with some of the remaining clay, then moisten and attach on the front of the boot.



10) Make a 2cm long rope with the remaining clay, moisten and attach to the backside of the boot as a pendant bail. Dry, smooth with a red sponge sanding pad (#320-600) and fire.



11) Polish the entire piece with a stainless steel brush, burnish the top part with a burnisher, attach the chain and finish.
